2020-21 Survey Results Quantitative

99 respondents from 231 surveys



- 1. Overall the school year met my child's individualized needs.
 - 80% Agree or Strongly Agree, 10% Neutral, 6% Disagree, 4% Strongly Disagree
- 1. My child's teacher did all they could to support my child.
 - 84% Agree or Strongly Agree, 5% Neutral, 7% Disagree, 4% Strongly Disagree
- 1. My child's case manager did all they could to support my child.
 - 84% Agree or Strongly Agree, 11% Neutral, 4% Disagree, 1% Strongly Disagree
- 1. My child's related services needs were met this year.
 - 82% Agree or Strongly Agree, 8% Neutral, 6% Disagree, 3% Strongly Disagree

2020-21 Survey Results Qualitative Noted Area of Strengths

Coded Responses = >10

- 1. Continuous communication from District, Case managers, Teachers, Related Services
- 2. The district increasing time for students with disabilities over time
- 3. Smaller class sizes
- 4. Incredible staff; teachers, case managers, related services

Coded Responses = >1<10

- 1. Virtual Social Skills
- 2. Great academic growth
- 3. Parents ability to view teaching and learning in action when virtual
- 4. Town Hall series
- 5. Reading Instruction

Coded Responses = 1

- 1. Outside breaks
- 2. Specific teacher names

2020-21 Survey Results Qualitative Noted Area of Weakness

Coded Responses = >10

- 1. Virtual learning for students
- 2. Lack of Social Opportunities
- 3. Lack of time with special area teachers; PE, ART, Music, Band

Coded Responses = >1<10

- 1. Hard for parents to manage virtual learning
- 2. Slow return of students with IEPs in some situations
- 3. Too much screen time

Coded Responses = 1

- 1. Too much communication hard to keep up
- 2. Too little communication from parents
