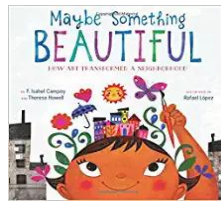


Stony Brook Summer Reading 2018

Hello students and parents!

This summer, the entire Stony Brook School community will be sharing in reading one book: *Maybe Something Beautiful* by F. Isabel Campoy and Theresa Howell. Based on the true story of the Urban Art Trail in San Diego, California, *Maybe Something Beautiful* reveals how art can inspire transformation and how even the smallest artists can accomplish something big!



Upon returning in September, all students will participate in similar activities to talk about and celebrate the book. To be prepared, it is strongly recommended that you read the book along with your child. As you read, you might want to discuss:

- ❖ The actions of the character
- ❖ The lesson that the author is trying to teach us
- ❖ How you can connect the book to your own experiences
- ❖ How you see art in our community
